# GAMES

<u>Eligibility</u> – This trial is open to all dogs measuring 20" or less at the withers and over the age of 12\_months, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

# Your dog must be registered with TDAA to participate in TDAA Trials.

# **CLASS INFORMATION**

#### Standard Class

**Beginner Agility** – All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. No grandfathering of titles from other organizations is allowed.

**Intermediate Agility** - Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Beginner Agile Dog (TBAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

**Superior Agility** – Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

#### Games Classes

**Games I** – All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. No grandfathering of titles from other organizations is allowed.

**Games II** – Only dogs that have earned the Games I (TG1) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

**Games III** – Only dogs that have earned the Games II (TG2) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

#### FEO (FOR EXHIBITION ONLY)

FEO– Runs are open to any TDAA-registered dog in any class. FEO dogs will run last in their jump height and may run on lead. FEO teams receive 1.5 times the SCT for their level. FEO runs do not count toward TDAA titles or certificates and no ribbons are awarded.

#### <u>Rekoons</u>

Rekoons is Snooker played backwards. Rekoons is a two-part game. The opening sequence in Rekoons is to perform the numerical sequence 7 - 2. After completing #7 obstacle (or faulting an obstacle in the opening) the dog is directed to collect points by doing different combinations of red (jumps) and obstacles. Rekoons is scored Points, Then Time. ER2

#### Poison

Poison is a bit of a fun outing game. In this game the handler works under the direction of a "Caller" who will call instructions with which the handler will attempt to comply. Poison will be scored Points Only. ER2.

#### <u>Mikey's Game</u>

Mikey's Game is a fun mixture of Tunnelers and What's My Line. After running a numbered course consisting only of tunnels, the handler must direct the dog to perform other obstacles on the field once (and only once) in the order and direction of his choosing. Mikey's Game is scored Time, Plus Faults. ER5

# JUDGE'S BRIEFING ON DAY OF TRIAL SUPERCEDES ANY PREVIOUS BRIEFINGS.

# **MULLIGAN**

Mulligan runs are offered. A "mulligan," is a situation where the handler is given the opportunity to re-run an event with the second run superseding the first. No more than one mulligan per day shall be allowed per dog. The handler must request a mulligan before the end of the class.

#### **NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS**

- \* The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- \* All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in designated areas (warm-up area). It is expressly understood the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, **no refund of any fees will be made**.
- \* Handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices.
- \* Food and toys are allowed in the ring in accordance with TDAA Rules and Regulations.
- \* Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- \* Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.
- \* At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar with or without tags or wear adornments, clothing, ties or other attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited.
- \* Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring.
- \* Entries will not be accepted without fees. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry Forms, one dog per entry form.
- \* Photocopied entries without the TDAA agreement on the back are NOT acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the trial. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.
- \* The Trial Secretary will add a \$30.00 service charge for any returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
- \* Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- \* No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- \* Bitches in season are not permitted at the trial. <u>The club will refund all but \$6.00</u> of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification from a veterinarian of such claim for refund to the Trial Secretary by 8:00 a.m. day of the trial.

## **Height Divisions**

TDAA offers the following Jump Heights: 2", 4", 8", 12", 16". Owners/handlers are responsible for entering their dog at the proper height division, both the dog's measured jump height and the height at which they want their dog to jump at the trial. Per TDAA rules, dogs may be entered at any jump height desired; however, the scoring height continues to be the dog's measured jump height. Dogs jumping at a height other than their measured height will earn qualifying legs and all TDAA titles. The judge reserves the right to measure dogs entered in any trial. Any dog that has not previously competed at a TDAA trial must be measured before competing.

## **Jump Height Exemptions**

In national competitions, such as the Petit Prix, dogs are required to jump at their measured height, as adjusted for any jump height exemptions to which they are entitled. Jump height exemptions are provided for dogs that are long-backed, have a weight-to-height exemption, or who have dwarfish legs (see <u>k9tdaa.com</u>, TDAA Rules and Regulations, Sec. 3.5.3 for descriptions of jump height exemptions). A jump height exemption (next lower height) will also be granted to veteran dogs (dogs at least 7 years of age) and a second exemption (two jump heights) will be granted to "double digit" veterans (dogs at least 10 years of age). You may subtract one height for veteran status, one for double digit veteran status, and one for body exemption from Measured Jump Height.

**Handicapped Handlers**: Disabled handlers will be allowed an additional 4 seconds in Standard and Games classes using numbered courses. A copy of a disabled parking permit must be sent with the entry.
